HOUSING

Housing in Bournemouth and Poole and the surrounding area is on average 30% cheaper than central London and a good choice is available to rent at less than £950 per month (for a 4 bed detached).

SHOPPING

Bournemouth's Castlepoint Shopping Centre has 40 stores and restaurants built over 645,000 sq ft of retail space. Castlepoint has the largest stores in the region for Next, Marks and Spencer and B & Q Warehouse.

The high street in Bournemouth also has Debenhams, Karen Millen, House of Fraser with new large Zara and H+M stores.

Poole has over 140,000 sq ft of shopping space with half inside the newly refurbished Dolphin shopping centre which also houses Beales.

A modern waterside 50,000 sq ft shopping centre, Dolphin Quays has opened at Poole Quay.
