The central areas of both Bournemouth and Poole are poised for major change that will significantly enhance the area as a retail, leisure and cultural destination as well as meet the demand for new housing and business workspace.

BOURNEMOUTH

Town centre regeneration will ensure the town's future as a thriving business centre, resort and a great place to live. As well as identifying areas suitable for development, there will be more open spaces and improved parking and transport.

Development proposals will give a major boost to the economy:

- A new high quality, 4 star hotel school. This will be the first fully commercial teaching hotel in the UK and a major educational innovation for the hotel industry.
- The Bath Road leisure complex will incorporate new leisure facilities, a casino, restaurants and roof garden.
- An 8 screen multiplex cinema and catering outlets.
- A full refurbishment of the Pavilion Theatre and adjacent piazza.

Boscombe seafront regeneration will comprise Europe's first artificial surf reef, a refurbished pier, 169 new apartments, landscaped piazza and events area, surf-themed retail and tuition facilities and a glass fronted restaurant offering superb panoramic views of the reef.

POOLE

Full Sail Ahead is a bold and ambitious regeneration scheme situated on the waterfront in Poole that will unfold over the next ten years, bringing with it a second harbour crossing, new homes, employment opportunities and public open space that together will lever in around £1 billion of investment.

- Up to 5,000 jobs and 3,000 new homes.
- New hotels.
- An iconic Twin Sails bridge.
- New public access to the waterfront.
- New public squares and open space.
- Improved traffic flows and access to the town and the port.

There are also major proposals for the regeneration of the town centre north area that will include significant levels of new retail floor space as well as leisure and residential uses. The development will support the cultural role of Poole town centre by creating high quality public spaces and improving connections to existing facilities such as the Lighthouse, one of the largest arts centres outside London.
