

Bournemouth Libraries provides a single shared E Book service, provided by [cloudLibrary](#). It's free to use with a membership card from any Bournemouth Library.



How does it work?

- Free to use. Check out up to 10 E Books at a time.
- Borrow E Books for up to 21 days - and return them early or renew (as long as there isn't a waiting list for the title).
- Reserve up to 5 E Books at a time in addition to your loans.
- Choose from over 10,000 titles - including fiction (for adults & children), biographies, history, cookery, travel etc.
- Download via the [free cloudLibrary app](#) to your tablet or smartphone - compatible with android and iOS devices, or [use the cloudLibrary website](#) if you are using a PC or laptop.
- No late fees - E Books expire automatically at the end of the loan period unless you have returned them early.

Due to security restrictions and limited bandwidth on the public computers and the need to install software it is not normally possible to use the E Book service in libraries. However, you can access them on your own device if the library has Wi Fi.

How to start borrowing - it's easy!

1. You can either [use a web browser to access the service](#) or [download the free cloudLibrary app](#), currently available for Android and iOS devices. When setting

up the app for the first time you will need to select language, country (UK & then England) and library name (LibrariesWest)

2. Log on with your library membership number – no PIN required.
3. Start browsing and check out titles straight away!
