

Millhams Community Recycling Centre Van Permit Scheme

Terms & Conditions

- A Permit provides permission to enter Millhams Community Waste Recycling Centre (CRC), Millhams Lane, Longham only. It is not a permit to deposit waste. This will be subject to the site's waste acceptance policy.
- Permission to enter/use Millhams CRC will be refused to vans without a valid Permit or an acceptable hire agreement document.
- A household may hold only one Permit at a time.
- The Permit is valid only for the vehicle described on the Permit. Permits are issued per vehicle, so any member of your household or driver you designate may visit the site with this vehicle using the Permit.
- Permit holders must make the Permit available for staff to check on each entry to the Millhams CRC and provide proof of residency.
- If more than one visit to Millhams CRC is made in one day, each visit will be counted separately and your Permit will be marked accordingly.
- The Permit is open-dated (no expiry date) from the date of issue. You will not need to reapply until **all the visits** on a permit have been used. The earliest an application can be made for another Permit is 12 months from the most recent issue date.
- If you change your address or vehicle please contact us. It is not acceptable to amend the Permit yourself. Defacing or amending the Permit will make it invalid. If you sell/return your vehicle, you must NOT pass on the Permit to the new owner.

- Millhams CRC operates an automatic number plate recognition scheme, and is monitored by CCTV. For more details please refer to: poole.gov.uk/nuffield
