**NAVITUS BAY – PRE-APPLICATION
CONSULTATION ON THE WIND PARK**

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that a key decision will be taken by the Cabinet on 16 October 2013 on the Navitus Bay Wind Park pre-application consultation.

The key decision is to allow the Council to comment on a document known as the 'Preliminary Environmental Information 3' which details the environmental information available from Navitus Bay to date and describes the potential impacts of the proposal and any mitigation measures deemed necessary to avoid or reduce the impact of the proposal on the environment. The document represents the applicant's current understanding and assessment of the potential effects so far on both offshore and onshore environmental topics.

The Council is unable to comply with Regulation 9 of the above Regulations in giving 28 clear days notice of the intention of the Cabinet to make a key decision relating to this matter. The reason why it is impracticable to comply with Regulation 9 is that a response to the 'Preliminary Environmental Information 3' document must be submitted to Navitus Bay by no later than 18 October 2013.

In accordance with Regulation 10(1)(a) of the above Regulations, the Chairman of the Environment and Transport Overview and Scrutiny Panel has been notified in writing of the matter about which the key decision is to be made.
