**Reasons for the decision: Subject to statutory advertising and
consultation on, Notice of Intention to make or amend the current
Order. There have been no objections to these proposals to vary the
2013 Order**

**Call-in and Urgency: The decision is subject to the council's call-in
procedures.**

**Background: BHLive propose to vary tariffs in Pavilion and
Bournemouth International Centre to provide a tariff for patrons to
shows in the evening and to vary the commencement of the evening
tariff to 11pm.**

**The Council and BHLive have received a number of complaints from
patrons concerning the tariffs. This variation will enable patrons to
purchase a single 5 or 6 hour tariff and therefore not worry about their
parking session finishing before the end of the show.**

It will lead to improved patron satisfaction.

Options - and reasons for rejection: N/A

Consultations undertaken:

Notices were erected in the car parks and a statutory notice was placed in Bournemouth Echo

Discussions held between BHLive and Bournemouth Council Partnership Manager. Letters were also sent to Chamber of Trade and Commerce, Dorset Police, Emergency Services and motoring organisations were consulted and considered concurrently with the period of Notice. No representation have been received for the proposed parking charges.

Finance/Resource Implications:

- The decision is as a result of BHLive Management responding to comments from patrons resulting in minor tariff changes.
- The decision has no negative financial implications and may result in a slight increase in income for BHLive depending on tickets purchased.

**THE BOROUGH OF BOURNEMOUTH
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013 Variation Number 1 Order
2014**

1. The Bournemouth Borough Council in exercise of its power under Section 35 (1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, has made the above Order.
2. The Borough of Bournemouth (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2013 is hereby varied by the variation to the Schedules below.
3. The Borough of Bournemouth (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2013 save as expressly varied as aforesaid shall continue in full force and effect.
4. The Order, which is operative on the date to be confirmed and may be cited as; The Borough of Bournemouth (Off Street Parking Places) 2013 Variation Number 1 Order 2014, will control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice which shows the classes of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period of waiting and the scale of charges for each parking place.
5. A copy of the Order may be examined at the Customer Service Centre in St Stephens Road on Monday to Friday between 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. and at the Central Library, The Triangle, Bournemouth on Mondays 10.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m., Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays 9.30 a.m. to 7.00 p.m., Wednesday 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. and Saturdays 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
6. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act, as amended, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date to be confirmed apply to the High Court for this purpose.
