



Southbourne Grove

Extract from Appendix 1 of the Bournemouth District Wide Local Plan (2002):

Southbourne Grove encompasses several, rather grand, early twentieth century terraces of shops, with two storeys of living accommodation, or offices above. Whilst only a minority of original shop fronts remain, the fine architectural detailing to the upper storeys, make these buildings an outstanding group well worthy of preservation. Additionally, the views from Southbourne Grove, along the side roads, provide glimpses of shapes, details and materials that encapsulate the character of Edwardian Bournemouth.
