



Wick Village

Extracts from the Bournemouth District Wide Local Plan (2002):

Paragraph 4.39

Wick village has a long history dating from the 14th century. A substantial proportion of the properties are listed, although some modern development falls within the conservation area boundary too. The village owes its reputation as the last village on the River Stour to its location and surroundings, and to its attractive character.

POLICY 4.14

The local planning authority will seek to protect the Wick conservation area from further infilling or redevelopment which does not preserve or enhance the character or appearance of the conservation area.

The construction of kerbs and additional footways, provision of modern street lighting and furniture and extensions of road lengths will not be permitted.
