### **Bournemouth Town Centre Area Action Plan (AAP) Adoption Statement**

This Adoption Statement gives notice that Bournemouth Borough Council resolved to adopt its Bournemouth Town Centre Area Action Plan on 5th March 2013. The document forms part of the statutory development plan for the Borough and sets out the vision and policies for the development of the Town Centre up to 2026. The Bournemouth Town Centre Area Action Plan was considered by an independent Inspector at a public examination hearing from 9th - 11th May 2012.

Any person aggrieved by the Bournemouth Town Centre Area Action Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power, or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications should be made not later than a period of six weeks starting with the date of adoption.
